The Rules

- Do not dominate the conversation or discourage participation by others
- Responses with excessive use of capital letters, bold or italic type or blank spaces are not permitted
- Participants may not misrepresent who they are, either in their comments or their commenting profile, or create multiple accounts
- Responses that are false, misleading or appear to be part of an organized campaign are not permitted
- Offensive language and profanity are not permitted
- You may not submit a comment or question that is abusive, defamatory, disrespectful, illegal, offensive or disparaging (whether on the basis of disability, ethnicity, gender, nationality, race, religion, sexual orientation, traits with which people are born, or otherwise)

- You also may not submit a comment or question that attacks, harasses or threatens another person, threatens or promotes violence, or wishes for harm to befall another person. This includes stalking or posting the personal information of any individual

- Responses with spam or self-promotional links are not permitted. This includes links to your own websites, blog posts, businesses or commercial ventures
